TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

Getting Mad.

VICTORIA, B. C., Aug. 21.—There is a general
feeling of indignation here in regard to the
further seizures of British schooners in Behring
Sea, from the fact that only British vessels
have been searched and their skins confiscated
and but one man placed aboard each to take
the vessels to Sitka.

The general belief is that the American
authorities are simply carrying on this practice
for the purpose of acquiring the skins and
frightening the sealers out of the sea, solely in
behalf of the Alaska commercial company's
interests, and not because of a belief in the
jurisdiction of the United States.

Squire Knocked Out.

SEATTLE, Aug. 21.—Last night's primaries
were the death blow of the political hopes of
Watson C. Squire and E. P. Ferry. Their defeat
was so overwhelming that their adherents
have no hope of mustering any formidable
opposition to Hoyt and Kinnear. The Times,
the organ of Squire, announces that his partisans
will accept the result and vote the repub-
lican ticket.

The excitement in this city did not abate to-
day and nothing else was spoken of.

Water All Rescued but One.

SYRACUSE, N. Y., Aug. 21.—Two steam
yachts, the Wide Awake, of Brewster and
the Jessie Land, of Phoenix, collided this after-
noon, and the latter sank and all on board,
about twenty five persons went into the water.
All were rescued by the Wide Awake except
Miss Clara Vonwerner, of Phoenix, who was
drowned.

SOMONA, Cal., Aug. 21.—Miss Alice Quimby
was watching honey bees at work on her father's
place, near Cucamonga, when several
thousands bees set upon her and stung her.
The young lady fell to the ground, where her
father found her unconscious. A physician
was called, and she was restored to conscious-
ness.
