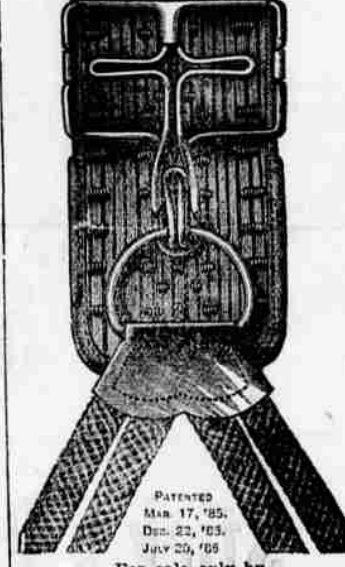

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

A Montana Convention.

HELENA, Aug. 27.—The democratic state convention this morning nominated for governor J. K. Toole, of Helena; for lieutenant governor, Howard Conrad, of Billings; for congress, Martin McGinnis, of Helena, Pemberton, of Butte, was nominated for attorney general; De Wolfe for chief justice; Armstrong, of Gallatin, for the five year term on the supreme bench; Beckford, of Missoula for the seven year term; Joseph A. Brown, of Beaver Head, for secretary of state; Perry Collins, of Cascade, for state treasurer; Thomas S. Fitzgerald, of Anaconda, for state auditor; J. C. Russell, of Butte, for superintendent of public instruction.

Cattle Dying.

KANSAS CITY, Aug. 27.—Reliable news from the southern line of Kansas and the pasture lands of Indian territory say that the herds of native and Texas cattle which range in that territory are afflicted with Texas fever or some thing. A man who has just returned from that part of the country states that hundreds of cattle are dying in the pastures south of Arkansas City.

DI missed.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 27.—The United States circuit court was officially informed today that the charge of murder against Justice Stephen J. Field had been dismissed by the Stockton court. Judge Sawyer accordingly dismissed the habeas corpus proceedings in the case of Justice Field.

Four Boys Killed by Lightning.

MATAMORAS, Mex., Aug. 27.—During a shower yesterday Carlos Kesendez and three other boys took a refuge from the rain in a shelter made of a stack of corn stalks. The stack was struck by lightning and all four were instantly killed.

A Big Earthquake

LONDON, Aug. 27.—An earthquake was experienced on the Russian frontier yesterday, in the village of Kheikonsk, 12,671 persons were buried alive.

Foreign Wheat.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 27.—The department of agriculture is in receipt of a cablegram from the European agent in London, stating that in the International grain market at Vienna it is estimated that the wheat crop of Europe is lower than expected and crops in Russia and Hungary are especially bad.
