TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

Ohio Convention
 DAYTON, O., Aug. 28.—The democratic state convention met in the rink this morning. The mention of the name of **Grover Cleveland** as the noblest and greatest living democrat, called forth long continued applause.

Nominations for governor were next in order and on the second ballot **Hon James Campbell** of Butler county, was nominated. The platform read and adopted begins as follows:

"First—The democracy of Ohio, in convention assembled, approve the declaration of principles made by the national democracy in St. Louis in 1888, and especially that part of it demanding a reduction of tariff taxes. We will continue the battle for tariff reform until the cause of the people is triumphant.

"Second—We regard trusts, in whatever form organized, as the legitimate result of our present tariff system, and we demand the repeal of all tariff taxes that enable them to extort from the people exorbitant prices for the products they control."

A Big Strike.
 LONDON, Aug. 28.—At a meeting of the striking dockmen this morning, **Burns,** the leader of the strikers, said that he had heard that 4000 Belgians would be imported unless the strike is ended. He at once telegraphed the **Belgian Workingmen's Union** and blocked that move of the employers.

The strikers number 150,000. The leaders express a determination to press their claims, and march through the streets until the demands of the dockmen are granted.

More Captures.
 SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 28.—A letter was received from the United States steamer **Richard Rush** by the steamer **St. Paul,** which arrived here from Unalaska last night, stating that on August 6, the **Rush** captured the British sealing schooner, **Lily,** of Vancouver, while taking seals in Behring sea.

The schooner was searched and 300 skins found, which were placed on board the **Rush.**

An Explosion.
 PORT TOWNSEND, W. T., Aug. 28.—The joiner in the lumber mill at Port Angeles exploded last week, seriously injuring two men, who are not expected to live, and badly bruising a third. The former, **Nicholas Meagher** and **Henry Campbell,** had their skulls crushed and faces horribly mangled. A piece of steel penetrated the left cheek and under the ear of **Meagher** that required a weight of ninety pounds to remove.
