It is amusing to see republican organs and politicians coming forward and explaining their overwhelming defeat in the late elections by saying that it is an "off" year. Well, truly this is an off year for them. A tidal wave has struck the country very like the one that struck it in 1874, followed by the election of Tilden to the presidency in 1876, and very similar to the one that struck the country in 1852 when the "tidal wave" governors were elected, followed by the election of Cleveland in 1884. It is very noticeable that, though they call it an "off year" our republican friends are deeply chagrined at the result. Without being inspired by temporary success, we should say that very many signs point to fact that the people are getting ready to elect a democratic president in 1892.

The personal rivalry between the President and the Judge and the unfortunate shape which Illinois politicians occupy against the President precludes Gresham's advancement.

**Causes a Sensation.**  
CHICAGO, Nov. 8.—Dr. Cronin's clothing and case of surgical instruments were found this afternoon and fully identified, and the discovery has created the greatest excitement among the officers of the state. It was stated in the court room that the clothes and case of instruments were found in a catch basin in Lake View, by Lieutenant Roche, of the Lake View station, not a hundred feet from where Dr. Cronin's body was thrown. It was afterwards learned that they were discovered at some little distance from the spot where the body of the murdered man was found, but in close proximity to the place where the bloody trunk was discovered.

**He Leaves for Turkey.**  
NEW YORK, Nov. 8.—Solomon Hirsch, United States minister to Turkey, sails tomorrow on the Etruria for his new post of duty Hirsch was a New York lad before he went to Oregon, more than a quarter of a century ago, and the cabins on the Etruria were quite crowded to-night with his friends who wanted to say goodbye. Among them was Judge Lachman, of the Sixth district court, whose mother is a sister of the new minister.

**Another Trust.**  
PITTSBURG, Nov. 8.—An evening paper reports the sale of the Globe Oil refinery of this city, the Freedom Pipe line to the Standard Oil Company. These refineries were the largest independent refineries in the country. The deal is said to involve several millions of dollars.

**Inaugurated.**  
HELENA, Nov. 8.—Governor elect Joseph K. Toole was inaugurated at 2 o'clock this afternoon. The official dispatch of Secretary Blaine that the president had signed the proclamation admitting Montana to statehood was discovered at 10:40 A.M. to Governor Toole, who signed for it at 11 o'clock.

**More Hands off.**  
SALEM, Nov. 8.—For some reason unknown to the outside world, convicts in the Oregon penitentiary continue to cut off, or attempt to cut off their hands. The latest to perform the self amputation was Cummings and Burke, from Multnomah county. The former succeeded only in part, getting off the end of one finger, and the latter made two bad hacks to the bone. Five have now performed this feat, and as a punishment will be kept in dungeons.
