THE PRIMARIES.

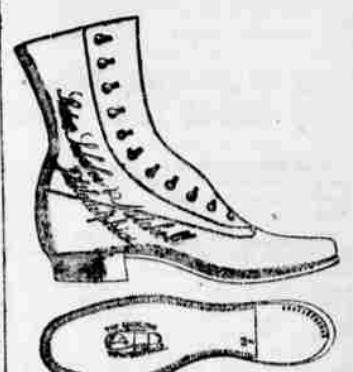
