

It is a curious fact that the Samoan Treaty framed by the two leading Protectionist nations of the world, China excepted, should provide almost unlimited free trade for this poor people. Heavy duties are laid on inoxicating liquors, tobacco, firearms and gun tpowder, but general merchandise is subjected only to a 2 per cent revenue tariff. If Comnissioners Phelps and Kasson had been true to their party they would have insisted upon free liquor and tobacco and a 47 per cent. tariff on other merchandise for the Samoans, on the high moral ground that the tariff would tend to theapen general merchandise and no tariff to enhance the price of whisky and cigars. But in truth, of course, Germany and the

United States wanted as free a chance to trade

with Samoa as possible, and, England being

naturally agreeable, the latter's economic policy

triumphed.

### TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

#### The Gentiles Victorious

SALT LAKE, Utah, Feb. 11 .- Everything in Salt Lake is quiet to-day and business has esumed its normal condition.

The official returns of yesterday's election received this morning give Geo M Scott, Gentile for mayor, a majority of 809. Louis Hyams, Gentile, recorder, 539. J B Walden, Gentile, treasurer, 659. E R Clute, Gentile, sassessor, 466. J M Young, Gentile, marshal, 773. The remainder of the Gentile ticket, includ-The remainder of the Gentile ticket, including fifteen councilmen, were elected by ma
jorities ranging from three to four hundred.
This gives them control of the municipal council for the first time in the history of the city.
The news soon spread over the city and the
Gentiles took possession of the city. Flags were
run up, and every Gentile building in the city
was decorated with flags and lanterns. Fire
works were sent up from hundreds of houses,
cannons booned and bonfires were soon upon
every corner.

#### The RIII Bill Passed.

OLYMPIA, Wash, Feb. 11.-The Hill Code bill, which has been the leading question before the legislature for two months, was finally settled in the senate to-day. It had passed last Saturday and this morning a reconsideration was moved. After two hours of debate, the motion was defeated. The bill is now ready for the governor's signature. It appoints W Lair Hill, commissioner to annotate and codify the laws of Washington. The total companyation is \$16.000. pensation is \$16,000.
