

THE JEFFERSON MILLS.—Some fifty farmers, of the Jefferson neighborhood, who had wheat stored in the mill warehouse there, and who recently closed it up and took possession of the property, met in the town hall of that city Wednesday afternoon for the purpose of ascertaining the exact condition of affairs, says the Salem Journal.

Mr. F. Bagley, chairman of the five trustees, was the heaviest depositor, and the great point of contention was over this gentleman's grain.

After deliberations reaching to almost dark, Mr. Forl made out an agreement which allows Mr. Bagley all the wheat he claims, and provided that all resources shall be divided equally pro rata among all depositors who had wheat there at the time the shortage was discovered. This was signed immediately by some 20 present, their desire being to avoid possible litigation.

The money for flour and wheat is not yet all in, but it is calculated that under the above arrangements about 48 cents per bushel will be netted to all parties.

A SENSELESS REMARK.—Sometimes even newspaper men put their feet in fact their whole body into it, as it were. The Salem Journal, generally a bright paper, made the following very thoughtless remark: "Every farmer who failed to get as much for his crop as he expected to get as a big yield as he hoped for vented his ill-will by voting against the republican candidate." Since then the farmers of Marion county have been going for the Journal in quite a red hot style. A more senseless remark was probably never made. If the farmers were to "go for" any one for such a cause it would be natural for them to go against the one in power, but they didn't, they went almost solidly for him. Crops and prices had nothing to do with it of course. The Portland non-taxable bonds did by a big majority.
