PORTLAND, Or., June 15th, 1890.

TEMPERATURE. The cool weather of the past five months was broken on April 29th, and warmer weather continued during May, giving to the month one of the highest mean temperatures on record.

PRECIPITATION. The average precipitation, 1.65 inches, is 1.00 below the normal. LaGrande reports 3.24 inches, the highest monthly total, and Hood River 0.19 inches, the lowest.

WINDS. The prevailing direction of the wind is northwest. The winds were generally light to fresh in velocity; no storms are reported.
