COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS.

An adjourned meeting of the City Council was held last evening. In the absence of Mayor Cowan, Councilmen Burkhardt presiding.

The Street Commissioner recommended several new side and cross walks, and other improvements.

A running grade was ordered made on Fourth street, from Baker to Railroad street, in response to a petition.

On report of the committee on health and police the Chinese houses of the city were ordered improved and changed in several specified respects, within twenty days.

Petition of Chas Pfeiffer and others to extend Calipoolia street sewer to ditch was adopted.

Matter of petition of E J Lanning and others for a wagon bridge across the ditch at Third and Thurston streets was referred.

Matter of petition for grading of Sixth street from Montgomery to Main was referred.

The matter of the petition asking that the flume on Lyon street be moved to near the center of the street by the Ditch Co., was continued.

Licenses to sell liquor were granted M Baumgart, Peter Schlosser, Chas Kiefer and H M Williams.

Matter of communication of L H Montanye was referred to the health and police committee.

On motion the ordinance in reference to knocking down grade stakes was ordered enforced.
