The work of Mrs. Henrietta Skelton, recently added nearly two hundred members to the W. C. T. U. of Lake county, Cal.

More than five hundred speeches a week will be made in the Nebraska campaign during July.

Worcester, Mass., is said to be the largest no-license city in the United States. A prohibition daily newspaper is published there, with good financial support. Even druggists are unable to obtain licenses, and this high sentiment is fully sustained by the leading citizens.

A correspondent of The Union Signal, in Topeka, Kansas, writes: "That decision of the Supreme Court has caused a great change to come over Topeka. The town is now full of 'original package' houses; the 'old saloon-keepers' that had squatted just beyond the state line, are all back with their packages, large and small, and are exulting over their victory." One result of this decision, and one in which all opponents of the liquor traffic may most heartily rejoice, and which already causes the more intelligent of the liquor men to be thoughtful and apprehensive, is that it has suddenly made the liquor question national, and a very live question in Congress. For the time being the original package liquor importer is "king," and he may defy any and all state authority save in his own state. But multitudes to whom his unrestricted reign is odious, are now calling with great emphasis to depose him, at least so far as his "original package" traffic is concerned. In the face of such an increasing popular demand, it is not probable that action by Congress will be long delayed.—National Temperance Advocate.

The people of the state of New York will vote upon a prohibitory amendment to their state constitution at a special election the second Tuesday in April, 1891. Already a call has been made by prominent temperance workers for a state convention to arrange for a thorough and successful campaign in favor of the amendment.

A territorial temperance convention was held recently in Guthrie, Oklahoma, which resulted in a permanent organization to be known as the "Oklahoma Temperance Alliance." Its purpose is to secure a prohibitory statute at the first session of the legislature.—Nat. Tem. Advocate.
