

MONEY IN THEM - This year the hay crop will bring a large amount of money to the valley. Lane county alone will receive a big benefit from it, though our crop is much smaller than that of Lane county, about which the Register says: "The hay crop of Lane county amounts to about 6,000 bales annually. As the crop this year is reported short, 4,000 bales or 600,000 pounds, it probably is a reasonable estimate of the crop of 1890. An advance of one cent per pound is an increase of \$200,000 to be put in circulation in Lane county. Since the market opened the price of hay has advanced fifteen cents per pound, which, if it were not for the fact that it is being sold at a lower price, but it is safe to estimate that our hay crop this year will bring \$2,000,000 to the county."
