MONEY IN THEM. — This year the hop crop will bring a large amount of money to the valley. Linn county alone will receive a big benefit from it, though our crop is much smaller than that of Lane county, about which the Register says: "The hop crop of Lane county amounts to about 6,000 bushels annually. As the crop this year is reported short, 2,000 bushels or 800,000 pounds, is probably a reasonable estimate of the crop of 1890. An advance of one cent per pound is an increase of \$500 to be put in circulation in Lane county. Since the market opened the price of hops has advanced fifteen cents per pound, which, if mine were yet contracted, would make an increase of \$12,000 to be circulated among our hop growers. Many growers have already contracted at lower prices, but it is hard to estimate that our hop crop this year will bring \$2,000 to the county."
