

THEY FEAR HIM.

No better evidence that the republicans fear Cleveland as a presidential candidate in 1892 is needed than the mere fact that they have now opened out all along the line a fearful personal war upon him entirely inexplicable, except upon the hypothesis that he will be the nominee of the democrats in 1892. The intensity of these attacks seems to be commensurate with the extreme character of the fear. The coarseness and low-bred manner of attack made by the *Oregonian* is simply on a par with the coarse, brutal attacks made by it on Tilden, Hendricks, Seymour, McClellan and other democratic leaders at the very moment when they were about to be laid in their last resting places. The secret of the viciousness of this attack upon the revered ex-president is to be found in the fact that Mr. Cleveland has a strong hold on the minds of thousands of decent republicans all over the country who admire him for his irreproachable integrity, who believe with him that public office is a public trust. The *Oregonian* and other republican organs seek to shake the faith of these broad-minded, liberal republicans in Mr. Cleveland, knowing full well that Mr. Cleveland if nominated for the presidency can not be beaten if the above element in their party be not alienated. They know he is the very embodiment of the strong feeling throughout the country in favor of tariff reduction so clearly and emphatically shown in the late elections, hence these attacks. The stupidity shown by the *Oregonian* in attempting to arouse a factional feeling between the friends of Hill and Cleveland is equalled only by its blindness to the factional hostility existing between Blaine and other leaders of its own party.

SAD HAVOC.

The late elections played sad havoc with the republicans in more than one way. In the matter of the election of governor, as well as congressmen, they were routed. The following states will have democratic governors when the newly-elected ones are inaugurated: Alabama, Arkansas, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, Wisconsin and Montana, making 28 in all while New Hampshire is in doubt. The republicans have the governors in fifteen states as follows: California, Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Maine, Minnesota, Nevada, Vermont, South Dakota, North Dakota, Washington, Idaho and Wyoming.

It is observed that Reedism received its death blow too. The speaker's field marshals were all made to bite the dust in the fierce conflict over tariff reform. The insolent Rowell, the coarse-grained Cannon, with Cooper of Ohio, Lacey, of Iowa, Greenhalge of Massachusetts, Comstock, Durrell and others all went down before the irresistible avalanche of democratic ballots.

The democrats in the next congress will have a majority of 28 over the republicans without counting a single vote from any of the southern states. The greatest gains made by the democrats were in the manufacturing states of the east and the agricultural states of the northwest.

Jacob Stehle, near Uniontown, Pennsylvania, is a veteran democrat. He is 106 years old. He was married in 1812, voted for Madison and every democratic candidate for president since that time. He walked glibly to the polls the 4th inst. and voted for Pattison for governor.
