Brazil is larger than the United States, but in the whole twenty states which make up the republic there are not as many people as we have in New York and Pennsylvania.

Public opinion traces the tired sensation in the eyes, noticeably by those using the electric light, to the small percentage of violet rays in the light.

The municipal government of London, which has a population of 4,500,000, costs the taxpayers \$25,000,000. The population of New York City is 1,500,000, and its municipal government costs the taxpayers \$38,000,000.

From reliable data the Oregon weather bureau estimates the following average yield for the state: wheat, twenty-six bushels per acre; oats, forty-two bushels; barley, thirty-eight bushels; rye, twenty-eight bushels, and hay, two tons per acre, except alfalfa, which averages four tons.

The theory that whiskey is necessary in the treatment of pneumonia has received a blow from Dr Bull of New York city, who discovers that in New York hospitals 65 per cent of the pneumonia patients die with alcoholic treatment, while in London, at the Object Lesson Temperance Hospital, only 5 per cent die.

Poor ministers in England have a source of revenue which we charitably hope will not be accorded to their brethren in this country. Instead of salting down their old sermons in barrels, they send them to the bookseller, who gets as much as \$5 a hundred for them. A London dealer offers 4,000 sermons in job lots at this price, and if they are written in "a large, bold, plain hand" they bring more.

It looks now as though within the next two months this country would witness more business failures than has been our lot for many years. The business of the country is in a bad way. Meanwhile congress does nothing to relieve the distress. The senate especially seems frittering away its time on the Force bill which adds still more to business disturbances.

France's public debt is the largest of any nation in the world. According to a recent budget report the debt amounts to 30,300,513,594 francs of nominal capital, or about \$6,000,000,000. Estimated on the basis of actual capital the debt amounts to 22,824,043,690 francs, or about \$4,500,000,000 in round numbers. The nominal rate of interest on this debt is 3.48 per cent and the actual rate is 4.62 per cent. On the basis of the first mentioned estimate the debt amounts to over \$150 per head of population. This, we need scarcely say, is very much in excess of the burden of debt per capita in the United States.

The democratic congressional vote in New York in 1886, the last "off" year before this, was 455,348; this year it was 508,873, an increase of 63,525. The republican congressional vote in 1886 was 442,865; this year it was 420,250, a decrease of 22,615. The year 1886 was the middle of the Cleveland Administration, and the president was sustained in the congressional vote by a majority of 5,000. This year is the middle of the Harrison Administration, and there is a majority of 88,000 against the president.

The McKinley law increased the duty on hops under the pretense that our hop raisers were being ruined by cheap foreign competition. The Seattle Press a few days contained the following:

One of the largest hop sales of the season was made Tuesday by the Snoqualmie Hop Grower's Association to S. Baxter & Co. The sale consists of 800 bales or about 160,000 pounds and representing probably \$60,000. Mr. Baxter, when seen about the sale, said: "Yes, we purchased 800 bales, but the price paid is private and cannot be given for publication. However, I will say that the hop market is now ruling at 35 cents. The hops we purchased from the Snoqualmie Hop Grower's Association are being delivered now, and when all in we will consign the entire lot to London."

So we are exporting hops to England. In fact, we export twice as much as we import.
