### TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

#### First Flight or Surrender.

PHILADELPHIA, S. D., Jan. 9.—Yesterday afternoon all commands in the field were ordered to march from three to five miles nearer the hostiles. Late last night the order was put into effect. At intervals of two or three days the effort will be drawn more tightly around the hostiles until they agree either to come in peaceably or be whipped into submission. The disposition they display to accept the overtures of General Miles are susceptible to but one interpretation, and that is that they propose to surrender and retain their arms or die in the defense.

#### Astoria & South Coast.

PORTLAND, Jan. 9.—President Bowley, of the Astoria & South Coast Railroad Company, and August C. Kinney, of Astoria, a gentleman largely interested in the same enterprise, have been in the city since Thursday, and are staying at The Portland.

During their short sojourn here these gentlemen have arranged for the payment to ex-President William Reed, the sum of \$50,000, this being his entire claim against the corporation.

"The building of that road we now consider an assured fact," said a gentleman prominently connected with the company last evening.

#### The Senatorship.

OLYMPIA, Jan. 9.—There was less talk about the senatorship today than any day since the fight began. Both sides have counted noses and are now working for gains. #### The Asylum.

SALEM, Or., Jan. 9.—The biennial report of the Oregon state asylum, Dr. Harry Lane, superintendent, will show many interesting facts. Two years ago the institution had 500 inmates, 358 male and 165 female. The number of admissions for two years was 443, and the discharged, deaths and escapes, 342. There were under treatment number 444 males and 184 females, a net increase in two years of 102.
