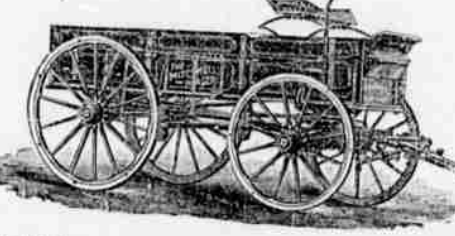

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

Window Dead.

NEW YORK, Jan. 29.—Hon. William Windom, secretary of the treasury of the United States, died tonight at 10:05 o'clock in the banquet hall at Delmonico's, where he was the guest of the New York Board of Trade and Transportation. He had been the toast of the evening. After he had finished his response he swooned at once, and died almost immediately. Every effort was made to restore him, but in vain. He died of heart disease. The great assemblage at once dissolved. Mr. Windom had been the only speaker, and the sentiment to which he responded was: "Our country's prosperity depended upon its instruments of commerce."

Died Unmourned.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29.—The entire attitude of legislation has changed since the force bill has been dropped, and there is every reason to expect that the urgent business of the session will be finished by the 3rd of March. There is little doubt but what the bill is dead. Republican senators who gave it a quasi support have notified the extremists they would not again try and get the bill up, and that it has had its day in court.

A Terrible Wreck.

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 29.—Late advices from Hong Kong state that the China Navigation Company's steamer Shanghai, while on her way from Shanghai to Hankow, Dec. 25 last, was totally destroyed by fire. There were over 400 Chinese passengers on board. A Chinese gun boat and steam launch, which were near at hand, made no attempt to save any one, but their crews contented themselves with picking up things that floated from the burning steamer. The number of lives lost is not accurately known, but is said to be between 200 and 300.

To be Electrocuted.

NEW YORK, Jan. 29.—James M. Slocum, the baseball player, who killed his wife, Ellen, January 1, 1889, and was convicted of murder in the first degree, was resented today to be electrocuted at Sing Sing in the week beginning March 10. Slocum was originally sentenced to die May 5 last, but got a stay pending an appeal. The appellate court confirmed the judgment of the lower court.

Gets a Big Building.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29.—Senator Dolph was watching the returns from the White House today to see if his Portland public building bill was approved, as this was the day it would have become a law by limitation. He was very much gratified to find that the president had approved the act several days ago and that Portland would have a \$500,000 building.

County Seat Agitation.

BROWNVILLE, Oreg., Jan. 29. A very large meeting was held in the city hall in this city last night in regard to a division of this county. Committees were appointed and steps will be taken immediately to have petitions circulated so as to ascertain the feeling of our citizens in this part of Linn county.
