TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.
What Congress Did.
 WASHINGTON, March 3.—The following acts
 passed by congress have been signed by the
 president:
 The direct tax bill; the act to prevent look-
 making and pool selling in the District of Col-
 umbia; joint resolution authorizing Vice Con-
 sul General Scidmore to accept the medal con-
 ferred upon him by the emperor of Japan; an
 act amending the act for the relief of volun-
 teer and regular soldiers of the late war, ap-
 proved March 2 1889; an act to pension the
 widow of General Thomas H. Hoffman; an act
 to establish circuit courts of appeal and to de-
 fine and regulate in certain cases the jurisdic-
 tion of courts of the United States; in regard to
 the treaty on reciprocity with the Hawaiian
 Islands; an act providing for the safe and
 humane transportation of cattle; an act for the
 erection of United States prisons and for the
 imprisonment of United States prisoners; an
 act amending the laws regarding the immigra-
 tion of aliens; an act granting pensions to
 Powell's battle of mounted volunteers; an act
 granting a pension to the widow of Rear-Ad-
 miral Porter; an act to provide for an ocean
 mail service between the United States and
 foreign ports, and to promote commerce, and
 an act regulating the granting or leasing of
 Hot Springs, Arkansas.

Hunt had to S. H.
 TACOMA, March 3.—The purchase of the
 Hunt system of railroads by Charles B. Wright,
 of Philadelphia, marks the final chapter in the
 history of the railroad exploits of Railway
 Magnate Hunt. The deal has been completed
 and the first payment of the price agreed upon,
 which was paid in Philadelphia Monday.
 The deal which has been in progress for some
 time past. Hunt has been in sore financial
 straits and badly in need of money. He re-
 cently was forced to abandon his proposed line
 to the Gray's harbor country on that account.
 By delaying the work of construction which
 had been begun on that line, Hunt lost the
 subsidies which had been promised him by the
 people of the various towns where the line was
 to have touched. The Northern Pacific is now
 earning practically the same subsidies by build-
 ing to that section.

The California Senatorship.
 SACRAMENTO, March 3.—Since Estee's
 arrival here the chances for United States
 senator, as successor to Hearst, are assum-
 ing a more favorable aspect. De
 Young is still forcing the fight, and has
 the support of the San Francisco delega-
 tion. Estee says he is in the fight, but
 proposes to discontinue any effort to
 win by money. He will not employ this
 method himself or allow his friends to do
 so. It will take sixty-one votes on joint
 ballot to elect a United States Senator.
 The republicans have eighty-eight mem-
 bers in the assembly and senate, sixty-one
 in the former and twenty-seven in the lat-
 ter. The assembly has enough republic-
 can votes, if all were thrown for the same
 man, to select the man.
