**TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.**  
**Fast Time.**  
 OGDEN Utah, March 4.—The Emma Juch Opera Company, en route to Ogden from the north, were today delayed in Idaho by a snow blockade. A special train was made on the side of the blockade, and all the passengers and baggage transferred. The special train ran seventy miles an hour for 250 miles, arriving here at 10 P. M. Emma Juch carrying out her engagement to a packer house. The performance lasted until 2 o'clock in the morning. The run from Idaho here was the fastest ever made to the west. The plucky little diva insisted on the throttle being pulled wide open. Many of the chorus girls fainted from fear.  
**The Evangelical College.**  
 LAFAYETTE, Or, March 4.—A special meeting of the educational association of the Oregon conference of the Evangelical Association convened in the seminary. The meeting was largely attended and exceedingly enthusiastic, J. Bowditch presiding. The association is highly satisfied over the condition of the seminary. Steps were inaugurated to advance the seminary to a college. This will be accomplished before the next school year. Dr. J. W. Watts, Professor C. A. Bowman, E. C. West, M. Fisk and Professor L. H. Baker were proposed and elected members of the association.  
**Mad at Boulanger.**  
 LONDON March 4.—There is semi-official authority for the statement that Lord Salisbury proposes to expel Boulanger from British territory. The government is deeply irritated by Boulanger's conduct in connection with the visit of the Empress Frederick to Paris. Boulanger is believed to have inspired the assaults in the Boulanger press upon the empress and to have planned even a greater insult than was actually directed to her.  
**A Horrible Massacre.**  
 LONDON March 4.—Later advices from Madagascar show that the probable massacre attributed by a sea captain arriving at Mascareilles to the French governor of Nossi-Bé, was in fact perpetrated by the Hova governor of an isolated province of Madagascar. The governor was provoked because a petition had been presented against him to the central government, and he perpetrated a most cruel massacre of nearly 300 men, women and children, slaughtering the victims in a horrible manner with many tortures.  
**Smallpox in Kansas.**  
 WICHITA, Kan, March 4.—There is great excitement in Chalmers county over the rapid spread of smallpox among the farmers, and so intense is the scare in the towns that the authorities have prohibited either entrance or egress, except by railroads. The number of deaths during the past few days is said to be alarming.
