WEATHER.

Continued cool, partly cloudy weather, with showers have prevailed. The nights have been very cool, several frosts occurring, which did no damage. A slight hail storm of small area occurred in Clackamas and Wasco counties on the 22nd, and in Washington county on the 27th.

Snow fell on the Cascades on the 17th and 23rd. Also in Morrow county on the 22nd which melted as fast as it fell. Some snow yet remains on the ground in Gilliam, Grant, Crook and Klamath counties, in the mountains the snow has not yet commenced to melt.

CROPS.

In the Willamette valley spring seeding and plowing has been greatly retarded. Seeding is farther advanced in southern Oregon, while in Umatilla county it is about one half done. In Morrow county an unusually large acreage will be sown. Throughout eastern Oregon the soil is well moistened and prospects for excellent crops are good. Throughout the state winter wheat is reported to have stood the winter well, to be of good stand and color.

FRUIT.—Fruit is very backward. The season is very favorable to it however, for it's being retarded now insures it against possible late frosts. Peaches, almonds and apricots are in bloom, in many sections; pear and cherry buds swelling. Currant, goose and strawberries in bloom.

STOCK.

The stock are reported in good condition. March range is good for them and there has been little loss during the winter. The lambing season is now on and there is very little loss.

HEALTH.

La Grippe is prevalent in some sections but no deaths; measles are common in various counties. The general health is, however, good.

The general conditions of the weather most needed are warmth and sunshine, with occasional showers.
