TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

An Old Fifer.
ROSEBURG, April 30.—The members of the Roseburg Board of Trade to attend the presidential reception at Portland will take along as their guest Jonathan Woodruff, an old pioneer of this state, who played the fife in a drum corps in the campaign of General William Henry Harrison at Evansville, Ind., in 1829. He is hale and hearty. His life is in tune and, notwithstanding his years and the accumulation of Oregon moss, can play "Yankee Doodle" in a way to attract the attention of even a money-making American. The old patriot wants to look upon the descendant of General William Henry Harrison, whom he assisted in electing president of this great country more than fifty years ago.

One of Them Caught.
CHICAGO, April 30.—A gang of "green goods" swindlers who have been fleecing the unwary by peddling to sell them counterfeit money, which really was packages of brown paper, has been operating in the west for some time. A few days ago one of them, named Tyler, was cleverly trapped by a hostess in a disguise. Today J. H. Thomas, alias Moore, who is said to be the leader of the gang and the cleverest "green goods" man in the country, was arrested in the United States Marshal's office. He boldly entered the office to arrange bail for his pal, when unfortunately for him, he was recognized by a citizen whom he had recently swindled out of \$350 in New York. He was held in \$5000 bail.

The Coos Bay Mill.
MARSHFIELD, April 30.—At a meeting of the directors of the Coos Bay, Roseburg & Eastern railroad last night, J. W. Bennett was elected vice-president; vice F. W. Burnett, resigned, and the officers were authorized to sign a mortgage and negotiate to raise funds, R. A. Graham, general manager of the road furnishes the Oregonian with the following information concerning the line: The work is now progressing very satisfactory owing to the settled weather. The company has floated \$2,500,000 in 6 per cent, thirty year gold bonds secured by a deed of trust to the Farmer's Loan & Trust Company, of New York.

What Put in a Mill.
EGGERS, April 30.—By a letter received from the Tacoma Mining & Milling Company, which is developing the mines on the Elbe river, it is learned that a representative has started east to purchase the machinery for working their ore. Samples of the ore have been brought out at regular intervals all winter, and especially during the last few weeks. The company has now gone so far that it is satisfied to put in a mill, which will be done at once.

Death of a Pioneer Woman.
HILLSBORO, Or., April 30.—Mrs. Thomas Stewart, sr., died here yesterday morning and will be buried tomorrow. Mrs. Stewart, who was well known and greatly respected in this town, was the first lady resident of Hillsboro, having arrived here with her husband in June, 1847. Her daughter, Mrs. E. J. Roberts, of Hillsboro, now here to attend the funeral, was the first white child born in Hillsboro.

The Total Sales.
PENDLETON, April 30.—The sale of re-creation farms was completed today. During its progress \$79,941.65 has been paid to recover McClelland. This amount includes improvements, and is something over one-third of the total purchase price, which is in the neighborhood of \$220,000.
