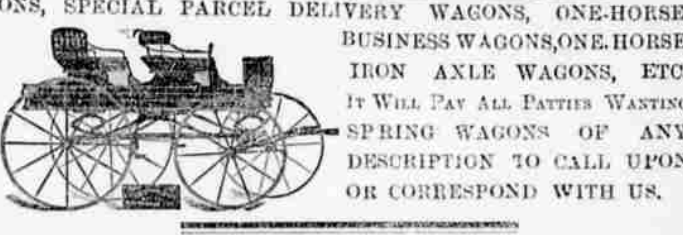

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

Sailing for Business.
SAN DIEGO, Cal May 12.—The steamer Crescent City, plying to Cerros Isala, off the Lower California coast, for a mining company arrived this evening. She sighted the Charleston about 6 o'clock Monday evening, eighty miles south of here. This indicates the Charleston is making eighteen knots an hour. The Itata is expected to transfer the arms got from the Robert and Minnie to the Esmeralda at Socora island south of cape St Lucas Sunday evening. The Itata took aboard about six hundred tons of coal here and, it is claimed, can steam fourteen knots on thirty tons per day.

The Michigan Fires.
LUDINGTON, Mich, May 15.—Some people who lived in Walkerville before the fire struck them have arrived here in a wretched state. They say it is impossible to tell how many inhabitants escaped alive, but they fear many died in the woods, where they fled for safety. The village had 800 inhabitants, and no one knows where more than half of this number are at present. Rumors of large loss of life at other points come in, but verification is impossible. This entire country will be swept unless rain comes today.

Served Him Right.
SEATTLE, May 12.—Leslie Bushnell, the English girl who sued W E Williams, of Seattle for \$10,000 for seduction under breach of promise of marriage, got a verdict for \$10,000 in the superior court today. The case had many sensational features. Williams met Miss Bushnell on the steamer while crossing the Atlantic a year ago and led her astray. This criminal intimacy was continued for several months in England, and they were constant companions. She says Williams promised to marry her and led her into the intimacy.

A Consul Snubbed.
NEW ORLEANS, May 12.—Consul Cortez has received a dispatch from Rome instructing him to return home and inform the government of the facts concerning the recent uprising. Cortez says he will return as soon as his government has obtained all desired information. This evening the grand jury replied to his recent letter, saying: "We find the tenor of your communication not consistent with the official dignity of this body, and it is therefore constrained to return the document without further comment."

Pennsylvania Fires.
HARRISBURG, May 12.—Mountain fires have been raging north and west of Harrisburg, but there has been no damage near the city. Railroad men report disastrous fires near Tyrone and Duncannon. At Huntington over 4000 acres of valuable timber lands are burning. The fire is beyond all human control and can only be extinguished by rainfall. Lock Haven is overhung by a heavy cloud of smoke caused by the forest fire.

A Cabinet Change.
CHICAGO, May 12.—Dr C K Cole, a leading citizen of Montana and one of Helena's richest men, received a letter from Washington today which stated that secretary Noble would resign in a couple of months, and that Thomas H Carter, of Helena, would be the new secretary of the Interior.
