## TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

**A New Confession of Faith.**  
DETROIT May 22.—The Presbyterian general assembly met at 9 o'clock this morning. After a session of prayer and conference the minutes were read and the standing committees announced. The stated clerk read a list of the Presbyteries that voted on the proposed change in the standard. Ninety-one voted aye seven nay, six refused to report and fourteen had not reported. The report of the committee on confession of faith was read by the chairman, Rev William C Roberts, president of the Lake Forest university. After reading the report it was moved it be sent down to the Presbyteries as recommended by the committee. The motion was unanimously adopted and the great debate is over this year so far as the general assembly is concerned.

**A County Alliance.**  
SALEM May 22.—The farmer's alliance met in the city today and perfected organization for a county alliance. There are five alliances in the county now, with a total membership of 134. The meeting was secret today. National Organizer Cole was present and helped to organize. The county officers elected are:  
President G W Weeks; vice president, James Taylor; secretary, T C Davidson; treasurer, Charles Miller; chaplain, F S Matterson; lecturer J H Daniels; steward, R E Downing; doankeeper, H C Libby; organizer, J B Henninger.

**A Lone Highwayman.**  
SPOKANE, May 22.—The people near Rathdrum, Idaho, say terrorized by a lone highwayman; who is operating a few miles east of that city. Yesterday afternoon three men were stopped at different places on the highway, one of whom went to Rathdrum, six miles away, and notified the authorities. A posse of citizens at once left town and are now scouring the country in search of him. No trace of him had been found at last accounts. The robber carries a Winchester rifle and wears a mask, and has been in that neighborhood for some time. If he is caught he will probably be lynched.

WASHINGTON, May 22.—Commissioner Raum, of the yensin bureau, today approved and signed a pension certificate in favor of John G Hildt, formerly of company K, First Michigan volunteer infantry, for \$16,500.

PARIS May 22.—La Siegle today reaffirms the truth of the reported Itata agreement, and says the Chilean steamer will be taken to a United States port and an embargo placed on her.
