WEATHER REPORT. OREGON WEATHER BUREAU. CENTRAL OFFICE, PORTLAND, OREGON. CROP-WEATHER BULLETIN NO. 13, FOR THE WEEK ENDING SATURDAY, JUNE 6, 1891.

(This bulletin is based on reports of 155 correspondents.) In western Oregon cool, partly cloudy and cloudy weather with occasional showers prevailed during the past week.

The weather conditions have been exceedingly favorable to cereals, causing the prospects for harvest to be extraordinarily good. General reports indicate the hay crop to be unusually heavy; wheat and oats to be in better condition than for many years, if ever better, at this season of the year.

In eastern Oregon a lower temperature than the previous week, together with partly cloudy weather and general rains prevailed. General crop prospects were never better, at this season of the year, than they are at present throughout this section.

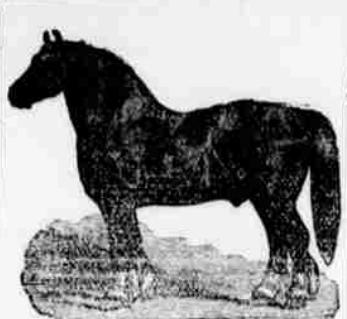

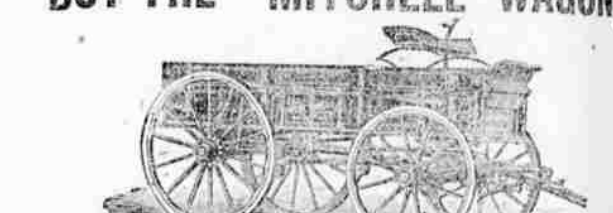
