Census Items.—The DEMOCRAT has received the census of South Carolina by small divisions. Every county has increased in population since 1880, except Newberry, which decreased 63. The greatest increase is in Spartanburg county, 57.06 per cent. Charleston increased 9.96 per cent. Piedmont increased 33.15 per cent, the greatest town increase.

In New Hampshire three counties show a decrease in population since 1880, Carroll, Grafton and Sullivan. Manchester increased 35.23 per cent. The greatest increase is that of Laconia, 62.08 per cent.

In New Jersey Haddonfield, Sussex and Warren decreased in population. The greatest city increase is that of Atlantic City, 138.36 per cent.

In Maine six counties decreased. The greatest town increase is that of Westbrook, 66.59 per cent. Portland increased 7.73 per cent, a great contrast to Oregon's Portland.

In Delaware one of her three counties decreased. The greatest town increase is that of Laurel, 63.60. Wilmington increased 41.02 per cent.

In Connecticut every county increased. The greatest city increase is that of Waterbury, 76.78 per cent.

Every county in Rhode Island increased. The greatest city increase is that of Johnston, 60.61 per cent.

These figures offer a strong contrast to those of the Northwest.

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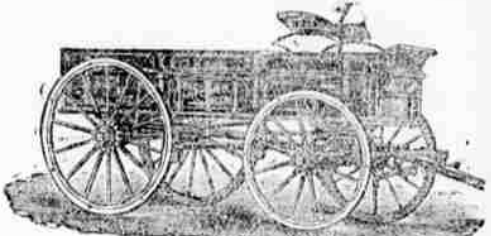
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
