DOG TAX.

ORDINANCE NO 218. SECTION 4.-The amount of taxes so assessed on each dog shall be due and payable to the recorder at the time such assessment is made by him, and if such tax is not paid to the recorder within five days thereafter, the same shall be deemed delinquent and the recorder shall immediately thereafter notify the person to whom such dog is assessed, in writing, that the tax thereon is delinquent, and that within five days thereafter, if such tax is not paid to the treasurer of the city and his duplicate receipt therefor presented to the marshal, that the said marshal will proceed against such person for the collection of such tax as by the ordinance for the collection of fines and taxes provided; and it shall be the duty of the marshal, if such person so notified, shall neglect or refuse to pay such tax within five days after receiving such notice from the marshal, to at once institute proceedings against him for the collection of taxes as provided by ordinance for the collection of taxes.

SECTION 6.-It shall be the duty of the marshal to immediately notify the recorder, upon his own knowledge or upon information, of any person who may be keeping any dog within the city limits upon which a tax has not been assessed and paid within one year, and upon receiving such notice the recorder shall at once proceed to make inquiry in regard to such matter and to assess such dog if he finds the same, and tax the owner or keeper thereof, as herein before provided.
