





A Terrible Cyclon

Baron Rouge, La, July 6 .- A cyclone om a southwesterly direction passed over the from a southwesterly direction passed over the lower portion of the town this morning at 6:30 o'clock unroofing houses, tearing up im-mense trees and carrying pieces of wreck through the a'r for many blocks. The boule-ward, a wide stredt, was littered with trees that were torn up by the wind and also pieces of house tops and other timbers. At the pen-tentiang the walls were blown down and ten persons killed and thirty wounded. The factory building was demolished and the hos-pital and penitentiary are a mass of ruins. In the city no one was killed, though several persons were seriously injured.
