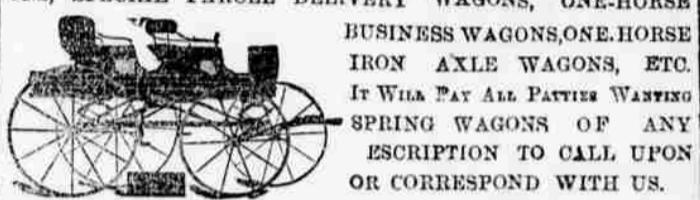

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

A Terrible Cyclone. BAYON ROUGE, La, July 6.—A cyclone from a southwesterly direction passed over the lower portion of the town this morning at 6:30 o'clock unroofing houses, tearing up immense trees and carrying pieces of wreck through the air for many blocks. The boulevard, a wide street, was littered with trees that were torn up by the wind and also pieces of house tops and other timbers. At the penitentiary the walls were blown down and ten persons killed and thirty wounded. The factory building was demolished and the hospital and penitentiary are a mass of ruins. In the city no one was killed, though several persons were seriously injured.

Steamer Sunk. LONDON, July 6.—Intelligence has been received that a large steamer was sunk off Dover some time during last night. The dispatches say that one mast of the vessel is visible above the water. The steamer Kinloch has landed at Gravesend a part of the crew of the sunken steamer, which was the Dunholme, bound from Middleborough to Rio Janeiro. The Dunholme was sunk at 2 o'clock this morning, two minutes after a collision with the Kinloch. Seventeen of the persons on board at the time of the collision are missing.

Big Seal Catch. VICTORIA, B. C. July 6.—The steamer Danube arrived with a collection of seal catches of the Victoria fleet this evening, totaling 18,000 skins. Several American steamers were also spoken with good catches. The Penelope's crew secured a dead whale and 300 pounds of whalebone during the cruise. The Danube goes to Behring sea with the British commissioners the 13th.

Mother and Child Drowned. FORT MORGON, Colo, July 6.—Fourteen-year-old Louis Yepton went bathing in a little creek yesterday. He struck a washout and was drowned. His mother on the bank tried to save him. The bank caved in and she also was drowned.

Trouble with Miners. OLYMPIA, July 6.—News of trouble between the militia and miners at Black Diamond was received here this afternoon, creating much excitement. The telegraph and newspaper offices were besieged by curious people. Major C. E. Sears, of Troop B, First regiment, leaves in the morning for the scene.

All Electrocutted. SING SING, July 7.—Stucco, Smiler, Wood the negro and Jugo were electrocuted successfully this morning, at 4:42, 5:14, 5:38 and 6:06 o'clock respectively.
