A French geologist has made a careful calculation of the amount of solid matter yearly carried off into the occan by the action of the rivers of the world and other causes. He estima es that the reduction of the average height of the surface of the solid land is 0,006 inches each year. Making allowance for the corre-ponding rise in the bed of the ocean, and taking no account of the occurrence of volcanic and other exceptional phenomena-the general tendency of which is to hasten the process of disinterigation-the period at which the solid land will have ceased to exist and the surface of the earth will be covered with water has been estimated. As, however, that period is 4,500,000 years distant, the prediction need cause no immediate disquietude.
