For six months the United States treas ury has been aware that an oplum-smuggling was in successful operation on the Pacific coast, It made its details for in vestigation with the utmost care, for it was difficult to find men who could be trusted Nobody from the section where the work had to be done could be employed, because the concern was all-powerful, and if bribery was not sufficient darker means might be employed.

Though it is difficult to get any positive information from the government officials enough has been given out to show that the full details are in the treasury's possession.

"We have full information as to the methods employed," said an officer of the treasury today, "but the difficulty will be in procuring testimony that will convict. The conspirators are American and Chinese, and though we know who nearly all of them are, our information is not in a form that can be produced in a court, I here is the trouble."

He had been a Captain in the artillery of the regular army during war and was breveted colonel for distinguished gallantry. He was a new man, and came out from Blooklyn and took hold with vigor.
