A LETTER ON OREGON.

Mr. A. B. Cumming, now of this city, in writing to the DeWitt, Iowa, Observer, says: I suppose you are thinking my letter is "Lang a-coming." I do not know hardly what to tell you in a short letter, as everything here is different from what it is in Iowa. We have the same people by races, but we are not the same in habits; you have an expression of free thought which is not used in this country. Your people say what they think and as they please on all subjects on the streets, or anywhere that is proper. Here the people are reserved and keep their sentiments to themselves. I attribute this reservation to the fact that the people are walled in on the west by the ocean and the barbarism of Asia, on the east by the mountain ranges and fifteen hundred miles of sage-brush and alkali desert; being thus isolated for years they have acquired the habit of thinking for themselves and keeping their thoughts to themselves. No one, to my knowledge, takes time to talk politics or religion, except there should be a political meeting, and they are far between, or in the churches or religious meetings. There are plenty of churches here of every denomination. If the people are not good it is not for want of churches; but they don't talk religion or politics on the streets, as they do in Iowa, hence we know nothing of their liberality or mental capacity on these lines. It is all business. Mammon has worshippers and devotees in plenty and his temple is well supported. How much God gets in the shape of true worship I do not know; but I do know that mammon gets his full share. The Almighty Dollar is the same fellow that is worshipped everywhere and on the "slope" his worshippers are most sincere. Well, let them worship, they have their reward and we pass no judgment.
I have been giving you a faint idea of how man has made himself here; now I will tell a little of what God has done for him: We have been here four months and more and we will say this is the finest climate we have seen, hence everything grows to perfection in the shape of grain, fruits and flowers. The finest wheat and small grain; the finest fruit from the cherry to the watermelon. No such in Iowa. This is the natural home of the cabbage, the cauliflower, the tomato and potato; they grow to perfection here. Fruit! my, such crops. I have seen plums growing on the stems and trunks and all the branches covered as thick as they could stick—great, big handsome fellows, as large as a peach. Pears! it would make you wonder where they come from to see the trees loaded with them, and the most of them as large as a cream-pitcher. But the handiwork of all their fruit is the Royal Ann cherry, as large as an Iowa plum, gold and red color. Well, you would wish your sense of taste, your throat and gastronomic apparatus, was as long as the Union Pacific railroad that you might taste them all the way. Yea, yea; a handful of these Royal Ann cherries is a whole peach orchard and watermelon patch all in one. All other kinds of fruit in the same proportion. Oregon can raise fruit for several states and then have enough left to beat California. This is the home of the sweet delicious fruit growing trees, and some day before long, will be world famous. So much for Oregon. Some time I will tell you who should come here and who should stay at home in the east.
