

SOUND AS A DOLLAR.

In a speech made by W C Brockbridge he said:

Now, what will be the effect if we put wool on the free list?

The first effect necessarily will be that it will cheapen the price of clothing, using the word clothing or raiment in its various forms; blankets, hosiery and goods of all sorts will be cheapened.

That is the first effect. If it had no other effect, is it not enough, in a country like ours to justify us in doing it? Is not that of itself sufficient?

But that is not all; for what is labor when you go one step further in the analysis? It is not merely to obtain necessities. That is the lowest view of it. Labor means the comfort of your wife, the education of your children, the happiness of your home, the growth and development of yourself and those you love.

Labor does not mean the mere necessities of life. It means the education of your children. Our opponents plead for workmen! With workmen I profoundly sympathize.

The second effect will be that it will make goods better. It will not only make them cheaper in money, but it will make them better in quality.

What will be its third effect? It will raise the manufacturer of America in a place he has never had.

He will be a competitor with foreign manufacturers in the markets of the world. With our labor, with our skill, with our credit, giving him free cost for his furnace, free wool his material, free dyes to dye that wool with, and cheaper machinery, you will find that he will do with that as Clarke of Rhode Island does with his manufactures—he will make them cheaper and better than anybody else in the world.

What will be the result? Why, our farmers will have prosperous manufacturers to sell to. His wool will be needed to make this better article to compete in the markets of the world with the woolen manufactures of other countries.
