TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

What Foster Will Do
WASHINGTON, Dec 20.—Secretary Foster makes no secret of his purpose of repairing, so far as possible within legitimate bounds, the serious inroads on gold holdings resulting from the recent heavy shipments of that metal to Europe. To that end he has renewed the policy employed by him at earlier periods of his administration, when the gold balance of the treasury was particularly menaced by foreign currency. This policy, in brief, is to disburse currency of any character and denomination desired at any point in the United States when it may be needed in any sub-treasury except that at San Francisco.

Asland City Election
ASHLAND, Or, Dec 20.—The city election today was held under the Australian ballot system for the first time. Two tickets were in the field, the republican and citizens', but there was not a warm contest as at previous elections, and only 360 votes were cast, resulting in the election of all republican candidates, except two councilmen in the first ward. The newly elected officers are: Mayor, J R Casoy; marshal, J W O Gregory; street commissioner, A L Helman; treasurer, E V Carter; surveyor, M L McCull; recorder, Milton Beyer; councilmen, first ward—R P Neill, Walter Beebe; second ward—J R Norris, H J Hicks; third ward—E P Loomis.

After the Frauds
PORTLAND, Dec 20.—Several employment agencies closed their doors yesterday and went out of business, the proprietors gracefully sliding away and taking successful means of covering up all traces of themselves. This was caused by the determined movement of the police, inaugurated Sunday and put into operation Monday, to crush the fraudulent employment agencies that for the past several days have so successfully victimizing innocent workmen.

A Gold Excitement
DURANGO, Colo, Dec 20.—The city has gone crazy over the reported discovery of rich placer diggings, located 150 miles from this point in Southern Utah, where the San Juan river empties into the Colorado. The excitement is unparalleled since the days of '49. Along the line of the Atlantic & Pacific railway, from Gallup to the Needles, the towns are almost depopulated, and 1000 men are already at the scene.

Fast Skaters
MINNEAPOLIS, Dec 20.—Hagan and McCormick, champion and ex-champion skaters of the world, met in a three-mile contest at the Normandia rink tonight. Great interest was taken in the result locally. Hagan won the match easily by 40 feet in 9:47. The race was for a purse of \$1000.

A Bold Robbery
TACOMA, Dec 20.—The Warwick saloon was entered tonight at 11 o'clock by two masked men with red flags drawn over their faces. They walked up to the bar, pulled revolvers on the barkeeper, and secured \$1200 in gold coin from the safe and filled and fled.
