A Terrible Affair! SAN FRANCISCO, Jan 12.—A Canton correspondent sends this account of a terrible disaster in a country town about 50 miles from Canton, which occurred early last month and resulted in the loss of nearly 2000 lives.

A Woman Stood Up! PORTLAND, Jan 12.—Miss Lizzie Rack who lives at 412 Couch street, was held up by a lone highwayman at 6:30 o'clock last evening on Couch street, between Eighth and West Park.

An Ex-Soldier's Suicide! EUGENE, Or, Jan 12.—A man was found dead on a pile of wood near the railroad, just south of Irving, this afternoon. His name was supposed to be George York, as he had a discharge in that name from the Fourteenth infantry, U S A, having served at Vancouver barracks. It is evident that he committed suicide by taking strychnine, the bottle being found near by.

Small Pox in Walla Walla. WALLA WALLA, Wash, Dec 12.—A case of smallpox was discovered in the city this afternoon. Last week Richard Orsino, an Italian, arrived from Wenatchee, Sunday he was taken ill, but physicians were not called until this morning. They pronounced the affliction smallpox. The patient was removed this evening to the pest house and placed in charge of competent nurses.

Socialist Powderly Talks. SCRANTON, Pa, Jan 12.—Grand Master Workman Powderly, in an address to the union carpenters, said: "I am a socialist and I say it without blushing. If the avowal brings condemnation, I am willing to take it. I am one of 65,000,000 socialists in this country. I believe the railroads and public highways should be nationalized, and that the telegraph system should be owned and operated by the government."
