

MAGNETISM OF IRON.

An important paper has been communicated by Prof. Knott to the Edinburgh Royal Society on the magnetism of iron by a current passing through it, the experiments being an attempt to obtain some insight into the nature of circular magnetism as it exists in an iron wire carrying a current.

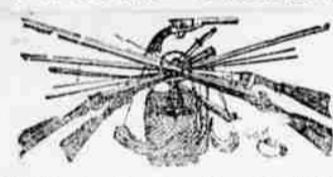
