TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

An Extra Session of Congress

WASHINGTON, June 30.—The president this evening issued the following proclamation:

WHEREAS, The distrust and apprehension concerning the financial situation, which pervaded all business circles, have already caused great loss and damage to our people, and threaten to cripple our merchants, stop the wheel of manufacture and bring distress and privation to our farmers and withhold from our workingmen the wage of labor, and

WHEREAS, The present perilous condition is largely the result of a financial policy, which is the executive branch of the government finds embodied in unwise laws which must be executed until repealed by congress;

Now, therefore, I, Grover Cleveland, president of the United States, in performance of a constitutional duty, do, by this proclamation, declare that an extraordinary occasion requires the convening of both houses of the congress of the United States, at the capital, at the city of Washington, the 7th day of August next, at 12 o'clock, noon, to the end that the people may be relieved through legislation from the impending danger and distress. All those entitled to act as members of the 53d congress are required to take notice of this proclamation and attend at the time and place above stated. Given under my hand and the seal of the United States, etc.

A Jackson County Murder.

JACKSONVILLE, Or., June 30.—Antoine Joseph, a Portuguese, who has resided on a farm on Williams creek, in Josephine county, 20 miles west of Jacksonville, was missing from his home the first of this week. As he was rarely known to leave his farm the neighbors became apprehensive and a search was made, resulting in finding his dead body a short distance from his home, with a bullet hole through his head. From indications, he was shot in a small trail near his house, and the body dragged into the brush where it was found.

D. A. Miller Appointed.

WASHINGTON, June 30.—At last the labor for the democracy of Colonel Robert A. Miller have been rewarded. He is made register of the Oregon City land office, succeeding John T. Apperson, who was appointed May 27, 1889. Colonel Miller left New York yesterday morning for home, very depressed and almost cast down because his appointment had not come. The place is worth \$3000 a year.
