

TIN PLATE FRAUD.

The tin plate factory at Elwood, Ind, has closed its doors. This is the institution which was opened with a blave of trumpetry during the campaign last year, upon which occasion Major McKinley was the chief orator. It was charged at that time that the plant was a mere bubble, and was established for political effect. A quantity of tin plate was made which was used in making republican campaign souvenirs, and this seems to have been the sole purpose for which the "factory" was established.
