AFTER THE SHERMAN LAW, WHAT?

There seems to be a general belief that the Sherman silver purchase law will be repealed or its operation suspended when congress meets in extra session.

But when the unfriendly law is repealed then what will be done? We do not believe the present congress, or any American congress, will take a step so threatening to the welfare of the people.

We have no word of commendation or defense for the Sherman silver law. On that measure the record of the Plaindealer is clear and consistent.

But the repeal of the Sherman law must be followed or accompanied by legislation that will place our money on a secure basis.

SPECIAL SESSIONS

The nation is 117 years old. During that time only eleven extra sessions of congress have been called.

Rutherford B Hayes called two extra sessions, as did also James Madison. The other presidents to whom fell this important duty were John Adams, Thomas Jefferson, Martin Van Buren, William Henry Harrison, Franklin Pierce and Abraham Lincoln.

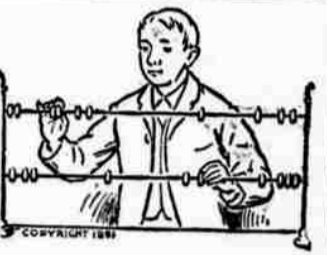
