TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.
Crickets Destroying Crops:
 OMAHA, Neb., July 14.—The crops of the west are threatened by the invasion of an army of crickets of the genus *eryllus*. They are now near Casper, Wyo., and are moving rapidly eastward, devouring potato fields in an incredibly short time. They are mostly together in solid ranks three-fourths of a mile deep, and are making a loud noise, which may be heard distinctly for miles. They will, at their present rate, arrive in Nebraska in time to harvest the sweet corn crop. The whole country is alarmed at their ravages.

Higher Freight Rates.
 EUGENE, Or., July 14.—The Southern Pacific Company is evidently intending to get even with the merchants who patronize the Oregon Pacific, and have raised freight rates from Albany to this city from 6 to 12 cents per hundred, but the rate has been reduced 2 cents per hundred from Portland. This makes the rate on sugar 85.29 per ton from Albany, and several merchants of this city threaten to have their freight unloaded at Corvallis and haul it to this city in wagons.

To Be Closed Sundays.
 CHICAGO, July 14.—The world's fair is to be closed Sunday, after July 16. The admissions of next Sunday have already been donated for the relief of the families of the firemen who lost their lives in the recent fire on the grounds, and but for this fact the fair would probably be closed next Sunday. The vote of the local directors recommending its former action was overwhelmingly in favor of closing, standing 24 to 4.

A Shipley Dead.
 CORVALLIS, Or., July 15.—A R. Shipley, a pioneer of 1852, died at 4:30 p.m. today at his residence, on College Hill, of heart failure, after an illness of several weeks. Mr. Shipley was born October 14, 1828, near Uniontown, Washington county, Pa. At the age of 9 years he moved with his parents to Mount Vernon, O., where he was married. In the spring of 1852, accompanied by his family, he crossed the plains to Oregon.

Pacific Coast Failures.
 SAN FRANCISCO, July 14.—The Bradstreet Mercantile Agency reports 29 failures in the Pacific coast states and territories for the week ending tomorrow as compared with 16 for the previous week and 21 for the corresponding week of 1882.

CORNALLIS, July 14.—Receive E. W. Hadley, of the Oregon Pacific, filed his May statement today, which shows earnings for the month of \$24,095, expenses, \$22,989; a gain of \$1,106.

A WHOLESALE MERCHANTS EXCURSION.
 The Oregon Pacific railroad company have arranged to run a Wholesale Merchants' Excursion from San Francisco to Albany on July 27th. The steamship "Willamette Valley" will leave with this party on the evening of that day, arriving at Yaquina on the 29th or 30th. The San Francisco Board of Trade will attend to this excursion in a party. It is the intention to entertain them in the same way that they entertained the Oregon merchants on their recent trip. It is desirable that these merchants should visit as many points in the Willamette valley as possible. They will be allowed five days to spend throughout the valley. Another Merchants' Excursion will probably be started for San Francisco on Aug 14th. All arrangements will be made to entertain them nicely upon their arrival in San Francisco.

THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD WILL SLASH THE RATES.—Officials of the Northern Pacific Railroad have decided to place low rates into effect. They will sell tickets from Portland to St. Paul for \$25 first-class, and make corresponding low rates to all eastern points. World's fair round trip rates will be greatly reduced. Tickets can be utilized on either of their through trains, both of which will continue to carry the Pullman tourist upholstered sleepers. Two trains daily without change.
