The Oregonian quotes a part of the silver plank in the democratic platform adopted at Chicago and then says it is utterly impossible to carry it out.

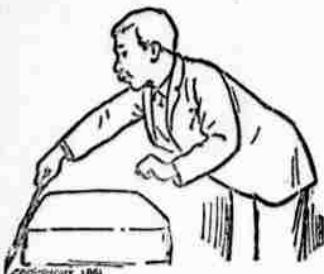
