POPULAR SCIENCE
The geological centre of the United States territory is in British America, 425 miles north of the Montana line. The average weight of adult Bostonians of both sexes is only 133 pounds. Western people average six pounds heavier.

German authority estimates that almost a third of humanity speak the Chinese language, that the Hindoo language is spoken by more than 100,000,000, the Russian by 89,000,000, while the German is spoken by 57,000,000 tongues, and the Spanish by 48,000,000.

A correspondent of Notes and queries, writing as to the age of trees, and to the oldest tree in the world, says that the age of the late Dragon Tree of Orotava was variously estimated at from 6,000 to 10,000 years. On the lowest estimate it surpassed not only Domesday Oaks and Soona Cypresses, but the Heisor Yew, with its 3200 years' and Alphonse Kari's Boisbals of Senegal. Jalfour gives the ages, as ascertained by DeCandolle, of the cypress as 350 years, the oak 1500, the Yew 2825 and the biobab as probably the same as the yew.

A GREAT CONVENIENCE.—World's fair visitors travelling via the Northern Pacific R R and Wisconsin Central line, are landed at the Grand Central station in Chicago. This magnificent fire-proof building, located in the heart of the city, has been fitted up as a hotel, run on the European plan, with about 200 rooms handsomely furnished and each room supplied with hot and cold water, electric lights etc. The charge for accommodations are reasonable, and parties can secure rooms in advance by calling upon agents of the Northern Pacific R R. By taking the Northern Pacific through the line to Chicago, visitors will avoid the discomfort of all transfer in that city, and can also travel between the Grand Central station and World's fair grounds by trains which run direct between the two points.

A WHOLESALE MERCHANTS' EXCURSION.—The Oregon Pacific railroad company have arranged to run a wholesale Merchants' Excursion from San Francisco to Albany on July 27th. The steamship "Willamette Valley" will leave with this party on the evening of that day, arriving at Yaquina on the 29th or 30th. The San Francisco Board of Trade will attend this excursion in a party. It is the intention to entertain them in the same way that they entertained the Oregon merchants on their recent trip. It is desirable that these merchants should visit as many points in the Willamette valley as possible. They will be allowed five days to spend throughout the valley. Another Merchants' Excursion will probably be started for San Francisco on Aug 14th. All arrangements will be made to entertain them nicely upon their arrival in San Francisco.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.
The Denver Banks.
DENVER, July 19.—The panic in this city continued this morning with renewed vigor, and as a result the old German National bank, with a reputation for stability of 20 years' standing, the equally reputable State National, and the extremely strong People's National failed this morning.

All night long depositors stood in line in front of the German National. At the opposite corner, where the State National has so long done business, was also a crowd of anxious depositors. These banks posted notices at 9 o'clock. The Peoples National closed at 11 o'clock. The run on the Denver National is over, with plenty of money still in sight. The same is true at the City and other unfailed banks. Business men are beginning to breathe more freely.

A Case of Relief.
WASHINGTON, July 19.—Everybody is nerving up for a long and hard siege of congress. It is generally considered a great affliction to the country when congress is in session, and there is not a newspaper paragraph in the country who has not taken occasion to write something to that effect; but at the present time congress does not come as an affliction to the people. On the contrary, all good friends of the government hope that it comes as a relief.

Prospect for Good Prices.
ST. LOUIS, July 19.—The Journal of Agriculture, of this city, treating editorially on the condition of the present wheat crop and the probability of an advance in prices, says the best American and European authorities agree the world's deficiency will be at least 100,000,000 bushels. The most reliable figures now place the total American crop of 1893 at about 383,000,000 bushels, which added to the surplus carried will make less than 450,000,000 bushels.

The Worst Fake Yet.
ALBANY, N. Y., July 19.—The International Cold Wave Company, with a capital of \$2,000,000 and a surplus of one-third that sum, has been organized by local capitalists, who expect to make untold wealth in the next few years. The company alleges that it has discovered a secret, the potency of which, if applied at the right time and under favorable circumstances, will visit and destroy the hot winds which arise in Kansas and at times have been known to sweep this country, burning and killing the growing crops.

Too Early For Such Talk.
NEW YORK, July 19.—General Joseph T. Torrence, of Chicago, a personal friend of Secretary Gresham, said yesterday that, although a republican, he voted for Grover Cleveland last fall. "But," he said, "I shall vote for Walter Q. Gresham for president in 1896. In my judgment he will be nominated by the democrats then. Do you suppose he would have resigned a life judgeship simply to be secretary of state? Well, I guess not."

A Big Fire.
SUNANVILLE, Cal., July 19.—A disastrous fire occurred here last night, resulting in the destruction of 60 buildings and causing the loss of about \$250,000. The fire started in an outbuilding of the Steward house and soon consumed the hotel. The flames then crossed the street to Cain's livery stable. A high wind was blowing at the time and the fire was soon beyond control.


