FROM THE WEBFOOT STATE.

One of the most important features pre-
sented to visitors is the magnificent educa-
tional exhibit, now fully open and complete,
in the department of liberal arts. Nearly
all the states and territories are creditably
represented. Particularly are the most dis-
tant states well represented, from the At-
lantic to the Pacific, and of these no exhibit
is more attractive than that presented by
the state of Oregon.

Its specific characteristics are numerous
and many of them unique, and at once hold
the attention of the passer-by. In the de-
partment of ornithology there is a magnificent
display of all the game birds of Oregon
elegantly mounted. There are free-hand
and mechanical drawings and photograph
work illustrating all features of public
school work through the several grades. Of
the higher institutions of learning the State
University, the State Agricultural College
and the Willamette University lead in their
exhibits. The entire exhibit is a splendid
tribute to the enterprise, skill and ability of
the teachers and school of the Web-foot
state.—Chicago Inter-Ocean.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

The Message.

NEW YORK, Aug 7.—The World's
Washington special says the following is
an authoritative statement regarding Pres-
ident Cleveland's message: He dwells
most particularly upon the deplorable con-
dition of the country as it affects the masses.
The banker and the broker and the
capitalists, he reasons, can take care of
themselves, but the workmen are prac-
tically helpless when such a condition of
affairs as now prevails exists. To substan-
tiate this argument he shows in concise
language the actual effect of the law known
as the Sherman act now in force. He calls
attention to the dearth of confidence arising
therefrom. He deals not in theories,
but in facts, to demonstrate the truth of
this assertion that the burdens inflicted upon
the country by this unwise law falls
most heavily upon the workmen. It is
for this reason that he believes that the
demand of the country is for its repeal,
and is so strong and universal that it is the
plain duty of all patriotic citizens, entrusted
with the responsibility of government,
to heed such demand. Therefore he recom-
mends an unconditional repeal, without a
hint of compromise or a substitute of any
kind. He notes the fact that the people in
the last election made an emphatic demand
for revision and reform in tariff legislation.
The pledges then made must be kept, but
since that time an unforeseen exigency has
arisen, and it must be met and mastered.
It is the plain duty of congress, therefore,
to afford relief to the country by placing
the repeal of the financial statute ahead of
all other contemplated legislation relating
to tariff or any other subject.

Killing the Whites.

LOUISVILLE, Ky, Aug 8.—The whitecaps
of Boone township, Ind., burned the house
of the Conrads tonight. Today three rider-
less horses, owned by three whitecaps, John
Kendal, William Fish and William Hub-
bale, were killed. It is thought the owners
had been killed by the Conrads, who have
returned from Kentucky. They say they
have three more men to kill. Harrison
county is excited as it never was before.

How They Stand.

NEW YORK, Aug 7.—The world's Wash-
ington correspondent has polled congress
upon the proposed silver legislation, and
says the repeal seems sure. There are 143
representatives in favor of the repeal, while
83 declare for a substitute and 22 will not
talk. Three senators declare against the
repeal of the Sherman law. Many members
of both houses who will not talk will un-
doubtedly vote for repeal. A large num-
ber of those who want substitutes are for
free coinage or against the demonetization
of silver.

Twenty-Two Persons Drowned

LONDON, Aug 7.—News of a sad ac-
cident to a party of excursionists was re-
ceived this evening from Port Talbot, Wales.
Twenty-eight pleasure-seekers took a boat
at Port Talbot and put out into Swansea
bay. A heavy sea struck the boat, capsize-
ing it, and twenty-two persons, including
several women and children, were drowned.
The others were saved.
