PLUCKING UNCLE SAM.

The astonishing discovery has been made by Pension Commissioner Lochren and his deputies that sixteen employees of the bureau, whose pensions were increased by their fellow-clerks without warrant of law during "Corporal" Tanner's regime, have never had their pensions reduced to the legal rate, though the increases were all regularly rescinded by Secretary Noble's orders transmitted to Tanner, together with a written opinion of Assistant Secretary Bussey in each case. For the past four years, therefore, these employees, nearly all of whom still hold positions in the Pension Bureau, have been drawing thousands of dollars from the Treasury upon receipts, the allowance of which caused the greatest scandal that had ever marred the administration of the bureau up to that time. The prompt action of Congress in demanding an investigation of these abuses, the dismissal of certain clerks and the orders of Secretary Noble restoring the pensions to their original rates were accepted at the time as all that could be done in the premises, in view of the opinion of the Attorney-General that recovery of past payments would be difficult, if not impossible. The public, however, will now learn through "The World" for the first time that the orders of the Secretary and Assistant Secretary of the Interior were ignored by Commissioner Tanner, placed in his private desk and afterwards turned over to Commissioner Raum, who also ignored them and kept them in his personal possession until he left the bureau, when he caused them to be secreted in the files of the law division, where Commissioner Lochren's sides have just found them.

It is a question which the law officers of the Government will be called upon to determine whether, in view of this wilful disobedience of the orders of their superior officers in the matter of disbursing public funds, a criminal case can be made against Tanner and Raum, but in any event the outrage stands fully revealed, and fairly overshadows all the other illegal and indecent acts of which these men have been guilty.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

Until August 24.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 12.—The silver debate in the house today did not attract much public interest. The knowledge that no vote can possibly be reached until Aug. 28 causes the members to take little interest in the proceedings and it is doubtful whether there was a quorum present in the house today. Many members left for the seaside last night resolved to remain until it should be time for them to return to deliver a speech, and nearly every member is preparing one on the financial situation.

Destroyed by an Earthquake.

ROME, Aug. 12.—Repeated shocks of earthquake have destroyed one-half of the town of Mattinata on the Adriatic coast. Stromboli volcano is in violent eruption. The inhabitants of Mattinata are camping in the open air. It has been ascertained that three persons were killed and four injured.

A Big Fire.

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn., Aug. 13.—Two million dollars worth of property went up in flames this afternoon. Over 200 houses are burned and at least 1500 persons rendered homeless. This is the record made by the destroying element in the short space of two hours. A kind providence, and not the fire department of the feeble efforts of the owners of the threatened property, saved the greatest portion of the manufacturing and residence portions of the East Side.

The Foot Race at Gervais.

GÉRVAIS, Or., Aug. 13.—In the 75-yard foot race today between George Givens, of the Red hills, and C. B. Berthwait, of Salem, the former was an easy winner by six feet. Both men were heavily backed by their friends. A number of sporting men of Salem went broke on their man. The country boys were fairly in it, and cleaned up over \$1000. Even money and plenty of it was wagered by both parties.

A Town Captured and Burned.

ZAVIYAH, Aug. 13.—Information was received here today from Witu to the effect that owing to the continued hostility of Fimo Omani, the deposed sultan, a landing party from the British warships recently attacked and captured the town and then set fire to it. The date of the capture is not given. Lieutenants Fitzmaurice and Giervis were wounded, and one man was killed. The natives fled.

Queen Victoria.

ST. JOHN'S, N.B., Aug. 13.—The Rev. L. G. McNeil caused considerable excitement in his church tonight by announcing that a cable dispatch had been received that Queen Victoria had been stricken with paralysis. No confirmation had been received up to midnight.
