The wild Cossacks, living away down in the southernmost part of the Russian Empire spend most of their time harassing the Turks. They are peculiarly savage in appearance. The top is of cloth or velvet. They form part of the Russian cavalry and live principally on plunder, scavenging, during their raids into Turkey, anything they can find from a chicken to a child.

The Crop Situation

NEW YORK, Aug 20.—The American Agriculturist's annual review of the crop situation says the harvest of 1893 in the United States in many respects is similar to three years ago, but with every prospect that the home consumption and increased foreign demand will so advance values as to yield as large net returns to farmers as the average recent years. Indeed, the review makes a distinct encouraging exhibit, in mitting the financial stringency may interfere with the early movement of the crops and have a temporary restrictive influence on prices.

Roberts was a thoroughly trustworthy man, and when he set out on his journey he had \$50 in gold in pockets. Yesterday morning his dead body was found by the Olney school teacher, lying beside of the road with his head terribly battered and cut.

Bread or Blood

CHICAGO, Aug 20.—Steps were taken today to organize a workmen's relief and aid committee, with a view to providing work for the large number of unemployed men in the city. A meeting of this afternoon. About 1800 were in attendance, all of them foreigners. The meeting was called ostensibly to devise ways of getting work for those who need it, but it soon turned into an old-time anarchist meeting, during which loud howls were sent up for bread and blood.

Five Persons Killed by a Train

LENOX, N. Y., Aug 20.—A carriage containing five persons on their way to church was struck by a train on the Lehigh Valley crossing and all killed. Their names are: L. J. Bovee, Mrs. Bovee, Miss Ola Bovee, Miss Nancy Wycke and Miss Emma Bowden. All were horribly mangled.

LONDON, Aug 19.—Gold to the amount of £110,000 was withdrawn today from the Bank of England for shipment to the United States. The Campania sails from Liverpool today with £265,000, and the New York from Southampton with £301,000.
