The report of the Secretary of the Treasury Dec 1, 1893, showed that there were in circulation on Oct 1 previous \$1,498,872,799 in gold coin, silver, gold and silver certificates, Treasury notes, United States notes and National Bank notes, or \$23,999 per capita, as against \$19,978 per capita in 1870 and \$20,377 in 1880.

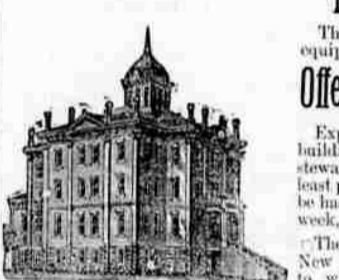
