LOOKING AHEAD.

Thomas Dolan, President of the Manufacturers' Club of Philadelphia, a Republican, of course, and a protectionist, has published a letter in which he takes issue with the hide-bound partisans who have been industriously misrepresenting the causes of the present condition.

I believe that the depression is almost wholly due to the silver policy. If the alarm was due to the victory of the Democrats, why was it not manifested last November?

He asserts also that the depression in the iron trade is caused not by fear of tariff revision but by overproduction. He warns his own party of the probable consequences of its foolish scare policy and takes a hopeful view of the future.

It appears to me that it is entirely wrong for the Republicans to keep harping away upon the same old campaign tactics. The democrats have fully three years in which to fight matters, and if the Republicans insist that the present depression is due to fear regarding the tariff, when business becomes brighter the Democrats will claim all of the credit and assert that better times are due to whatever changes in the tariff laws they may have enacted.

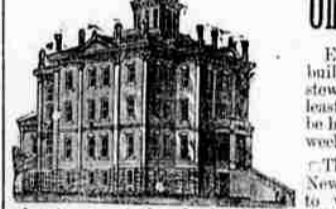
