Judge J. White, of East Portland, died August 28, 1893, at his residence on Hawthorne avenue and Thirty-fifth street, from a complication of diseases, at the age of about 60 years.

The deceased belonged to the early comers to this state, locating at first in the vicinity of Milwaukee, where he married the daughter of a Scotch Campbell, prior to 1850.

He subsequently moved to Clackamas county, where he was elected county judge, and afterward a member of the lower house of the legislature.

Returning to Multnomah county later, he served four years in the state senate from this county. The decedent was highly respected for his genial disposition and the honest execution of his convictions.

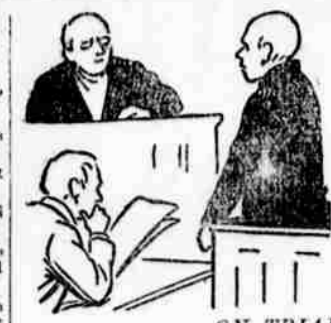
