Senatorial courtesy is a lovely thing when it is put forth to insure the right of patient hearing and full deliberation; but when it is made a mask for mere mulishness, and wilful intent to obstruct tegistation and defeat the popular desire, it be-comes an abuse. The Senate should be courteous with limitations. The amendies of debate cannot be safely carried to such an extent as to prevent Senators from the discharge of a grave public duty requiring immediate action. It has not yet been brought forward in the ways and means committee, as it is the policy of Chairman Wilson to formulate a tariff bill in advance of any provision for increasing the revenue by internal taxation. In discutsing the matter to-day Congressman Whiting, of the ways and means committee

"I am strongly in favor of an incom tax, which I believe to be the fairest plan for the distribution of the burden of taxation. My idea of a tax is that it should be about five per cent a year on fixed incomes of \$2,000 and over. I do not think the graduated tax a fair one, as, owing to the instability of large incomes, there is no justice in putting such a burden upon them as would imperil the permanency of large financial enterprises. I take no stock in the communistic idea of levying a tax that would prevent the amassing of much wealth, I would simply make large properties pay their share towards the support of the general Government

"I hear a good deal of talk about the difficulty of collecting an income tax, but I think that with our modern methods and improved public service we would find little more trouble than is experienced in collecting taxes on personal property. I think it might be well to incorporate in such a bill as I speak of a provision for a tax on legacies such as has been successfully levied in several States. No valld objection can be made to such a tax and the lacome from that source would be considerable,"
