Congressman Cooper, of Florida, one of the ablest of the young democrats of the House, expresses the opinion that the populists will make very few converts in the South as the result of the unconditional repeal of the purchasing clause of the Sherman act. The southern democrats, he predicts, will stand by their colors, and refuse to pass a harsh judgement on the Administration they have helped to create because of a single act with which they are not altogether in sympathy. They will wait and see what the outcome of the supplemental financial legislation is to be before even seriously listening to appeals to form new political alliances.

Mr Cooper, like other southern leaders, is expecting Congress, at the regular session, to pass a measure increasing the volume of the currency. He says nothing about the free coinage of silver, but mentions the repeal of the tax on state banks and a law authorizing national banks to issue notes up to the par value of their bonds as measures that may meet the emergency and satisfy the people.

These views of the Florida Congressman, who voted for unconditional repeal, are in exact keeping with the views of other southern men. As long ago as last July Gen Catchings, of Mississippi, predicted in an interview printed in The World that when the test came the south would not be found wedded to free silver. What the south wanted, the Mississippi Congressman said, was a larger circulating medium, and the only reason why she had always supported free coinage was that no other plan for increasing the volume of money had been thought forward. Gen Catchings himself has always been opposed to free coinage and still opposes it, and yet is the most popular member of the House from a State whose two Senators are leaders in the silver camp.

The best opinion here among Southern men of the more progress stamp is that long before the Congressional elections of next year this democratic congress will have completely taken the wind out of the populists' sails by legislation that democrats everywhere will approve and applaud.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS.

Hawaiian Affairs: WASHINGTON, Nov 12.—Whatever recourse the administration may have determined upon to secure the restoration of Queen Liliuokalani, it is very evident Secretary Gresham does not expect extreme measures will have to be resorted to. The course proposed to be pursued seems to be to request the present government, in the name of the United States, to give way quietly to restoration of the queen. Hawaiians in this city are very firm in the conviction that the government will refuse to yield to any such gentle persuasion.

Discriminated Against: CORVALLIS, Or, Nov 11.—Some of the employees of the Oregon Pacific under the former receivership, and people who have furnished supplies to be used in the operation of the road, have filed a petition alleging that Receiver Hadley has received very large sums of money since his appointment, which have not been disbursed by him in payment of wages and current expenses of his receivership, and of which no account has been rendered by him, and that in the payment of labor bills the receiver has discriminated against labor claims assigned to storekeepers. The petitioners ask an order requiring the receiver to make immediate payment of the moneys due the petitioners.

Worse Than Bullets: NEW YORK, Nov 12.—An American recently returned from Brazil after a long residence, says: "It seems to me it is an outrage to enlist men at this period of the year to go to Brazil. Yellow fever a month hence will be raging furiously in all sections where fighting takes place. I predict that 99 per cent of the men going on the Brazilian fleet will never return alive, even if they escape the bullets and torpedoes of the insurgent fleet."

Money for Missions: MINNEAPOLIS, Nov 11.—The general missionary conferences met at Christ church today and made appropriations for the work among the Chinese as follows: California, \$75,000; Oregon and Puget sound, \$100,000; Southern California, \$100,000.

A Boy Shot: OREGON CITY, Or, Nov 12.—This afternoon Belden Tull, the adopted son of Sheriff Ganong, was shot through the foot while out watching some boys shooting at objects thrown in the air. It will lame him, even if the foot is saved. It was purely accidental.
