The democratic tariff bill will probably be published much earlier than has been anticipated. The resolute tariff reformers have been warned by the attitude of the moderate tariff men in the party since election that the chances of party success and discipline depend on boldness and promptitude in defining their policy, and therefore all haste consistent with deliberation will be made in completing the bill and giving it to the public. 




