**AIR AND CONSUMPTION.**

A writer in the August Century recommends deep breathing with arm exercises as a preventive of consumption. There is no doubt as to the efficacy of this course, for consumption, except in imputed cases, is unknown in high altitudes, the light being so light that deep breathing is mechanical. Few of us use our lungs to their full extent. The practice of trades and callings that require close attention has given to many of us a slight stoop and a falling forward of the shoulders that confines the lungs, while the lack of robust exercise to stimulate the physical mechanism leads to a faint panting that goes nowhere near chest deep and that continues in sleep. We cannot all be soldiers, sailors, hunters and blacksmiths, but most of us can straighten up at our work now and again and give the starved lungs a full drink of air. Exercise, even in some incidental way, such as the mountain climber, the fisherman or the sportsman encounters in pursuit of his hobby, is so tiresome that few can persevere in it. Sparring and kicking at the atmosphere, bending and reaching at nothing, require more than ordinary courage and method to continue for more than a week. It may be all right in theory, but in practice it is a tedious nuisance. An occasional fall breath involves no hardship and puts the body to no strain, and probably the results are as efficient as much exercise.

One fertile cause of consumption, and perhaps, if statistics were obtainable, the most fertile of all causes, is the breathing of stale air. Our shops and offices are poorly ventilated, and our homes, particularly in winter, are worse. There are housewives to whom sunlight is poison and fresh air is dangerous. They go about their parlors in a twilight, treating the peculiar mustiness of carpets and upholstery that they save from fading at the cost of their health and that of their families, and they grow bleached and yellow and live as susceptible to ailment as those who twice a more normal life. If it were not for broken windows and rickety doors in city tenements and out-door occupations by day among the farmers, the ravages of phthisis, foolish spelling, that would be much worse than they are; for there are thousands of people who shut themselves into their rooms at night as hermetically sealed as may be. The smell of those rooms in the morning, charged as the air is with animal exhalations, is horrible.

A strange and wholly unaccountable notion prevails among such people, who are usually of the illiterate class, that night air is unhealthy, so they collect a few cubic feet of day air in their bedrooms and breathe it over and over again until it is fairly rotten. The continuance of life under such conditions is a marvel. Night air is the same as day air, except that it is cooler and fresher, and with the subsidence of industry it has less of gas, dust and smoke in it than the air of noon. It is, therefore, the fittest air to breathe that there is, and he who denies it to his lungs at night denies one of his greatest needs and invites the speedy corrosion of his lungs. Thus it is that in farming districts, where rugged health ought to prevail, we see stooping shoulders and pale faces and hear rasping coughs. Let the air in everywhere; let us have more of it in our places of work, let us have more of it in our theatres, especially let us sleep in it. Breathe it heartily, to the bottom of the lungs, and there will be no more consumption.—Brooklyn Eagle.

**The Tariff Bill.**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 12.—The schedules of the tariff bill were completed today by the ways and means committee, and a portion of the features was devoted to the administrative features of the bill. The republicans think the bill will not be submitted before Saturday next, while the democrats think to submit it by Thursday. There is no certainty of a caucus of the democrats on the tariff bill, as some of the democrats most anxious for changes in the bill are opposed to a caucus.

**A Long Walk.**

NEW YORK, Dec. 12.—Fred Miller, the pedestrian, and his dog, who started to walk from San Francisco to New York June 25, arrived here today. He states he met with no trouble except want of food when he crossed Arizona and New Mexico. Miller left Buffalo eleven night. He brings cards and an entry book signed by postmasters along the route. He says all through New York state he was treated kindly. He looks well, but says he is weary. He weighed 115 pounds today, being a loss of 10 pounds since starting.

**A Receiver Appointed.**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 12.—Lionel V. Stagg, who has been national bank examiner, was today appointed receiver of the Oregon National bank. Stagg made his report to controller Eckels, and, after going over the affairs of the bank, the receiver was determined upon. Eckels says the appointment was unexpected, and was made because he believed Stagg was well qualified for the place.

**A Boy Murderer.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 12.—Henry Dack, a 12-year-old boy, whose parents live on Diamond street, this city, shot his 6-year-old brother Jesse through the heart this evening, killing him instantly. The little fellow was arrested for murder though it is clear the weapon was accidentally discharged while the boy was trying to force a cartridge that was too large into the cylinder.

**The Anti-Lottery Law.**

BOISE, Idaho, Dec. 12.—The United States grand jury today returned indictments against W. R. Hurst, proprietor, and T. T. Williams, business manager, of the San Francisco Examiner. The indictments charge them with violation of the anti-lottery law in circulating copies of the Weekly Examiner through the mails with an advertisement of a prize scheme for securing subscriptions.

**Two Boys Convicted.**

ROSEBURG, Dec. 12.—Harry Lehnerr and Otto Kenyon, two boys who were indicted for larceny from General Holmes, in Camas valley, were sentenced this morning by Judge Fullerton. Kenyon received one year in the penitentiary and Lehnerr was ordered for an unlimited time to the reform school.

**A Change of Venue.**

COLFAX, Wash., Dec. 12.—Judge Sullivan has granted a change of venue in the Ed Hill murder case to Dayton, where it will be tried before Judge Guernsey March 12.
